## **Emergency Procedures**

## **Exposure Incident Procedures: Chemical, biological, radiation, etc.**

- Alert all persons nearby to the type of emergency (i.e. spill, exposure, fire).
- Wash it off, rinse it out: use eye-wash, sink, drench hose, or shower to remove the hazard from skin or clothing. If needed remove contaminated clothing to reduce duration of exposure to hazard.
- Evacuate the area or room as needed. If evacuating the room, close the door behind the last person exiting. If flammables are spilled and your safety is assured, turn off any ignition devices.
- Contact your faculty supervisor, College Safety Coordinator (801 422-6875) and/or University Police (801 422-0911). If after hours or on weekends, contact BYU Police at (801) 422-0911 for advice and assistance or Provo City Police at 911. Be prepared to provide the type of emergency, as well as your location and phone number where you can be reached.
- Seek Medical attention Go to the BYU Student Health Center (across the street from the MTC) during daytime hours. After hours or off campus – Go to the nearest urgent care or emergency room.
- If you have been potentially exposed to a Bloodborne Pathogen, If during open hours proceed directly to the BYU Student Health Center, if after hours go to UVH ER. Contact your faculty supervisor, College Safety Coordinator (801-422-6875) and/or University Police (801 422-0911).
