All students in the Life Sciences College seeking to add a minor are required to complete the Life Sciences College Minor Form before a minor can be added. If adding a minor will require you to enroll in more than 8 Fall/Winter semesters, then you're encouraged to take Spring/Summer terms.

Please allow up to two weeks for the review process. You will be notified via your BYU email (NetID@byu.edu) once your minor is approved or denied.

You will need to petition (**Part 2 of this form**) to add a minor if you have:

- Over 90 BYU credits (not including language challenge exam credits or transfer credits) **OR**
- A double major **OR**
- A currently declared minor **OR**
- The minor is not related to your major (see the "Explore Related Minors" form on <https://lifesciences.byu.edu/advisement/minors>)
