- Over 90 BYU credits (not including language challenge exam credits or transfer credits) OR
- A double major **OR**
- A currently declared minor **OR**
- The minor is not related to your major (see the "Explore Related Minors" form on https://lifesciences.byu.edu/advisement/minors)
