- Hazardous materials are defined as those chemicals present in the workplace that are capable of causing harm. In this definition, the term chemicals include dusts, mixtures, biological materials, reagents, radio nucleotides, fertilizers and common materials such as paints, fuels, and solvents, etc. This definition does not include standard “household” items such as canned air, hand sanitizer, hand soap, etc.
- For University tracking purposes, when purchasing hazardous chemicals use the spend category SC6114.
- Any hazardous material items purchased directly from BYU Central Stores or BYU Chemistry Stores should be charged to the SC6114 spend category.
